THE INTENSIVE STUTTERING CLINIC

Over three million Americans stutter, approximately 1% of the US population. The impact of stuttering can exceed its severity, thus affecting a child's self-esteem, school success, social wellbeing, and quality of life. As such, the focus of therapy targets stuttering acceptance and advocacy. Our message remains consistent: It's okay to stutter. In addition, the Buffalo State University Intensive Stuttering Clinic incorporates Stuttering Modification and Fluency Shaping therapy approaches as appropriate.
