## THE INTENSIVE STUTTERING CLINIC

Over three million Americans stutter, approximately 1% of the US population. The impact of stuttering can exceed its severity, thus affecting a child's self-esteem, school success, social wellbeing, and quality of life. As such, the focus of therapy targets stuttering acceptance and advocacy. Our message remains consistent: It's okay to stutter. In addition, the Buffalo State University Intensive Stuttering Clinic incorporates Stuttering Modification and Fluency Shaping therapy approaches as appropriate.

### Program Goals:

- Enhance acceptance of and self-advocacy for speech and stuttering to diminish the negative impact
- Understand speech and stuttering thoroughly
- Manage and modify stuttering and associated behaviors
- Improve communication ease and spontaneity

**Family participation** is vital to the success of the program and is encouraged. One to two parent group meetings will be hosted as an avenue for learning and open discussion.
