### Credentialing Information

Your program has been planned in a sequential manner to include the academic and clinical experiences you need to meet eligibility requirements for three credentials. Upon successful completion of the program, you will be *eligible* for:

1. **American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) Certification - Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC).** This is a voluntary professional credential but is often required by employers. ASHA CCC's is a **national** credential, valid across all states, and is required for student supervision.

2. **New York State License:** This credential is required by law for practice in non-educational settings in New York State. [New York State License Requirements for SLPs requirements](#)
3. **New York Certification - Teacher of Students with Speech and Language Disabilities (TSSLD).** This credential is required to work in a public-school setting in New York State.
