Graduate School Information

- **GPA:** Maintain a high GPA. You need at least a 3.0 to qualify for *most* SLP graduate programs.
- **Accredited Programs:** Research accredited programs and application requirements at [ASHA Program Directory](#)
- **Letters of Recommendation:** Obtain letters of recommendation, remembering that *graduate programs have different requirements for the number of letters and qualifications of letter writers*. Ask your course instructors to write letters for you toward the end of the **fall semester of your senior year**.
- **Application Deadlines and Procedures:** Apply to graduate school(s) during the winter break of your senior year, remembering that *graduate schools have different application procedures and deadlines*.
- **Graduate Record Exam (GRE):** The graduate SLP program at Buffalo State University does not require GRE scores, however some programs do. Prepare for and take the GRE **prior** to applying to graduate school, if scores are required for the schools to which you will apply: [GRE information](#)
